

LESSON PLAN

- ALLAH MADE THE SKY -

Level: 1 **Theme:** Allah Made Everything – Allah Made Nature

Topic: Allah Made the Sky

Context: neurotypical preschooler, or special needs student who may be pre-K age or may be

older

Duration: 1 hour, will vary depending on student/class **Prior Knowledge:** None required

Materials:

- 1 Social Story for teacher to read to students; and 1+ Reader for each student, from <u>al-m.ca/SpecEd</u>; each printed single-sided, inserted in perforated sheet protectors, in fastener folder reinforced at corners with packing tape
- 1 Flashcards set, printed according to desired size (e.g. 2 pages per sheet, 4 pages per sheet), cut-out and (opt.) laminated
- 1+ Activity Card for each student
- Yellow crayon/marker/pencil crayon
- Blue glitter, silver glitter
- Glue-stick or glue-sponge with a paintbrush for applying glue to Activity
- Safety scissors
- String/ribbon
- Optional: audio/video of relevant rhyme/nasheed of choice; maximum 5 minutes

Language Skills Addressed: Initial sounds include "s" for sky, stars and sun; "m" for moon **Skills and Strategy Focus:** Recognition of sky, moon, stars, sun

Selected Level 1 Outcomes and Specific Objectives:

<u>Listening:</u> Student will listen for the beginning sound and be able to visually match it with associated picture

<u>Reading:</u> Student may begin to recognize the sight words "can," "see" from Dolch pre-k level <u>Speaking/Signing:</u> Student shall learn to make the sound/sign for the associated picture <u>Fine Motor/Gross Motor:</u> Student will practice colouring, cutting with assistance, applying glue and sprinkling or shaking glitter onto Activity card; Student will point up to sky, and make sun shape with arms as ability allows

Assessment: Teacher will note anecdotally if student was able to identify the image correctly; and if sound of word was made

Follow-up: Parents/Caregivers should have student use Reader booklet, flashcards at home.



Procedure Outline:

- 1. Teacher will read the Social Story to the students. Teacher will encourage student to say/sign the words "sky," "sun," "moon," "star" with initial letter sounds.
- 2. Teacher will present flashcards. Teacher will repeat with each student until goal is achieved. Hand over hand or body map may be used to help the student.
- 3. Movement Break: Teacher will have students make action for a sun, making a circle with arms, as ability allows; they can make a sprinkle motion for stars; teacher can play a relevant rhyme/nasheed as well, helping students move around room while waving arms. Encourage them to say the words sun, moon, star or sky as they come up in video.
- 4. Activity: Teacher will present Activity Card and model the activity, assisting students as needed (see card itself for directions).
- 5. If time allows, teacher will read Reader booklet aloud; and then assign as homework.
