Tweet, Tweet! It's Fun to Pray!

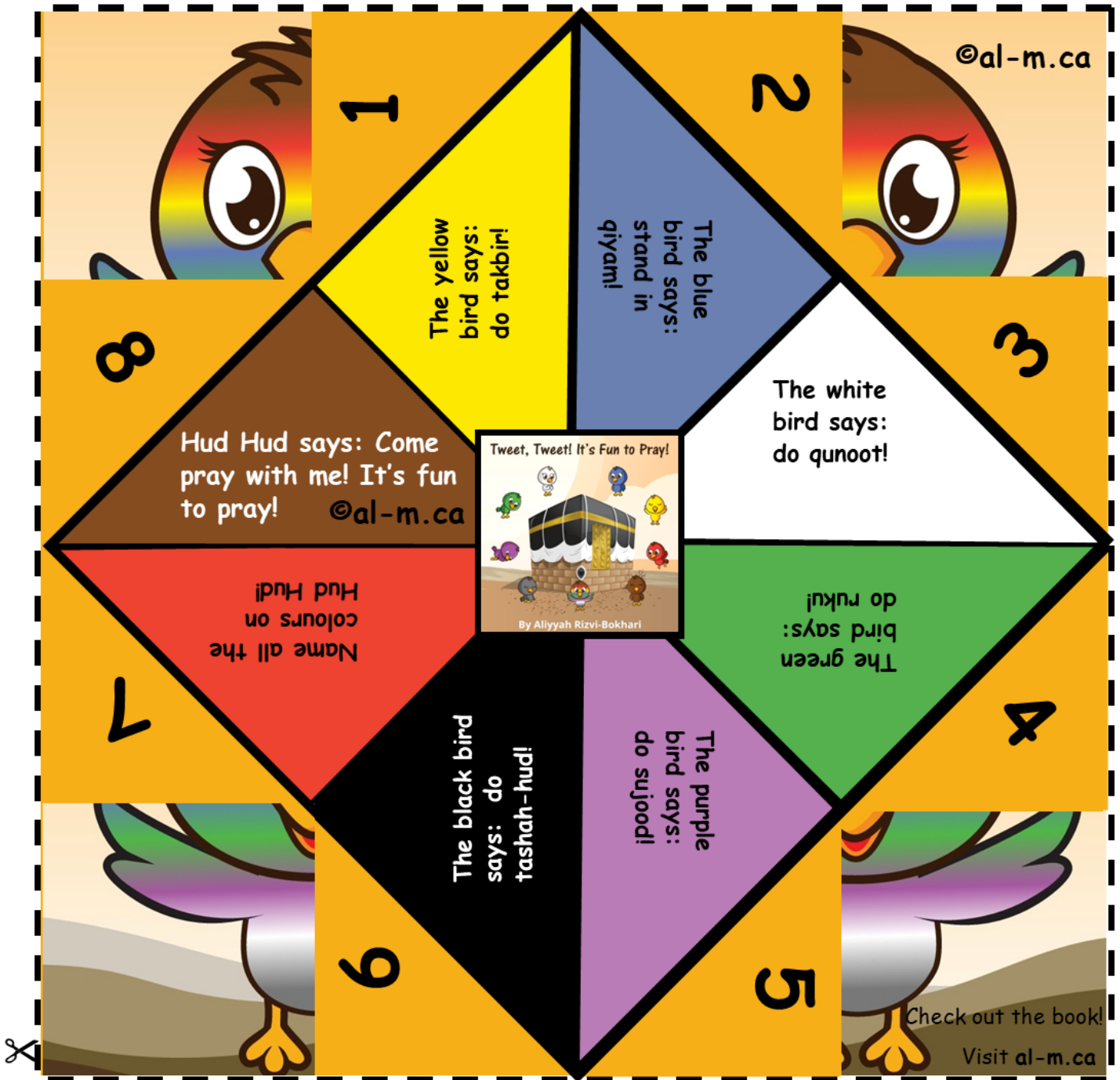
Objective: Associate the names with the actions of salat; maintain recognition of actions when they are presented in random order

Number of players: 2+ See more activities at <https://al-m.ca/tweet-tweet>

Let's Play!

1. After assembling the fortune teller, have the other person pick a part of the bird, e.g. Right Eye, Left Eye, Right Wing/Foot, Left Wing/Foot.
2. Alternate pinching and pulling out the fortune-teller corners horizontally and vertically, with each word of the phrase, saying "Tweet, Tweet, It's Fun to Pray!"
3. Have the person pick a number from the fortune teller.
4. Alternate pinching and pulling the corners according to the number while counting.
5. Have the person pick a number again.
6. Open the selected number flap and say the name of the action, e.g. say "The green bird says 'Do ruku'" and have the person act it out. If they are correct they can earn a point. Note: For the brown bird flap, the person gets a free bonus point.
7. Switch turns. The player with the most points after 5+ rounds wins!
